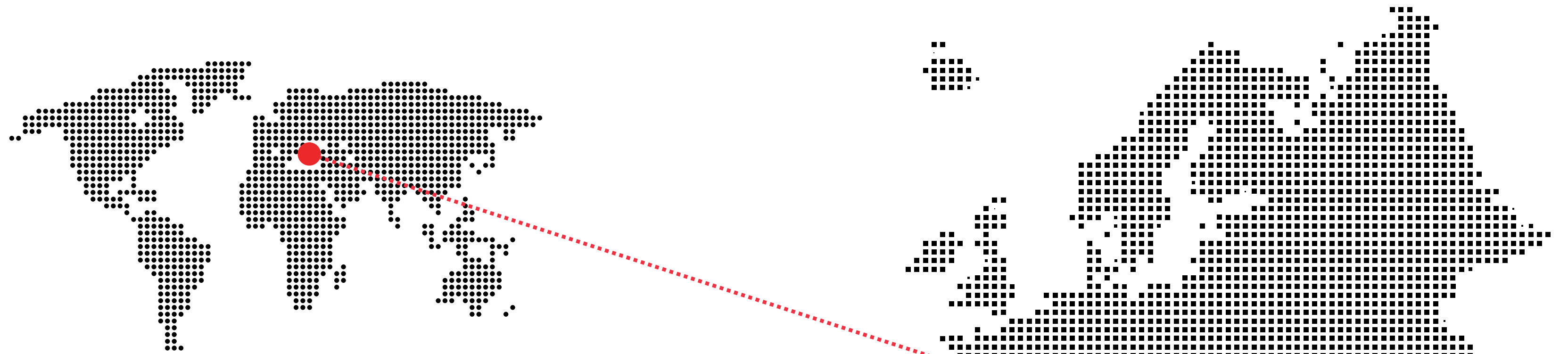

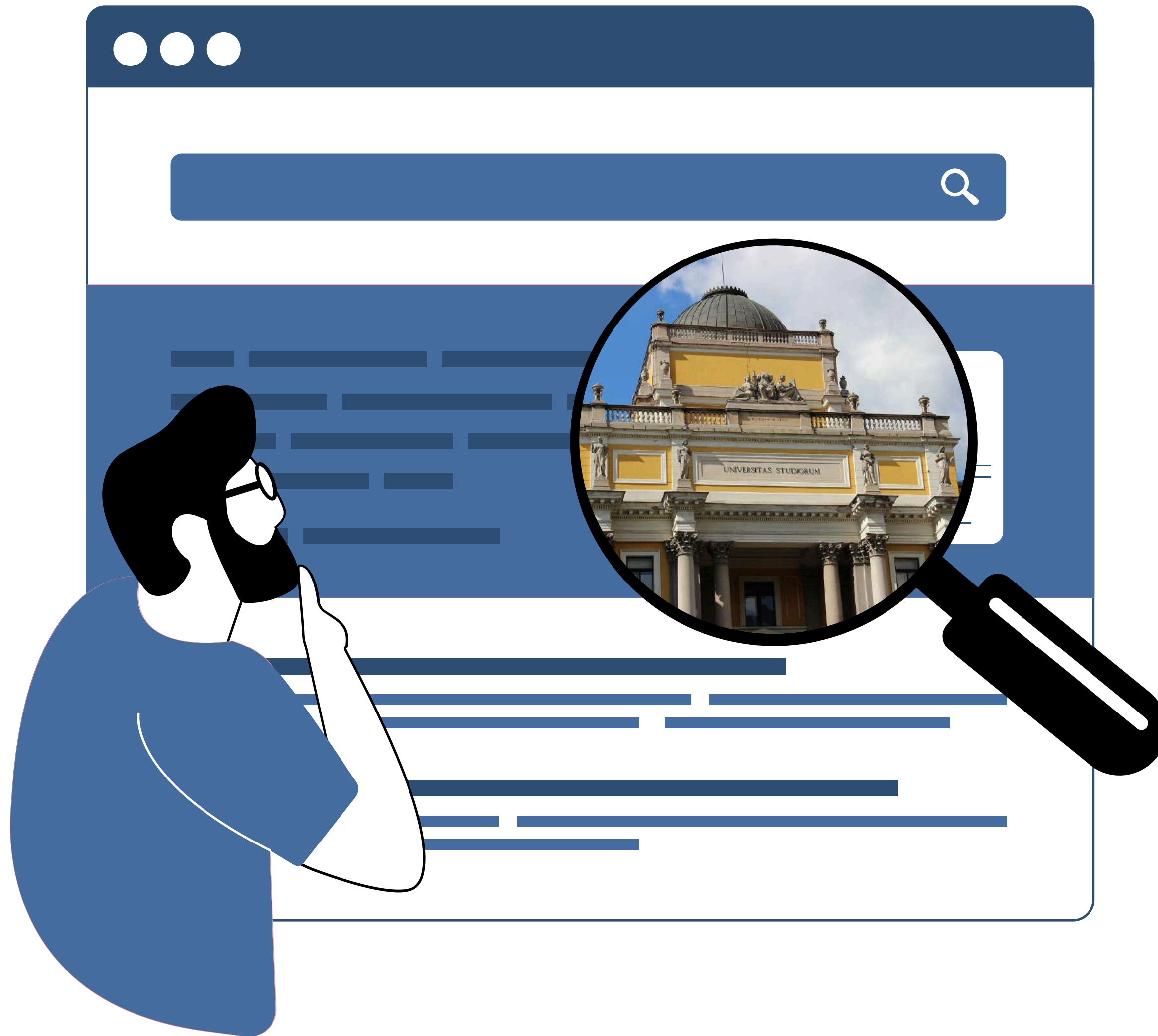

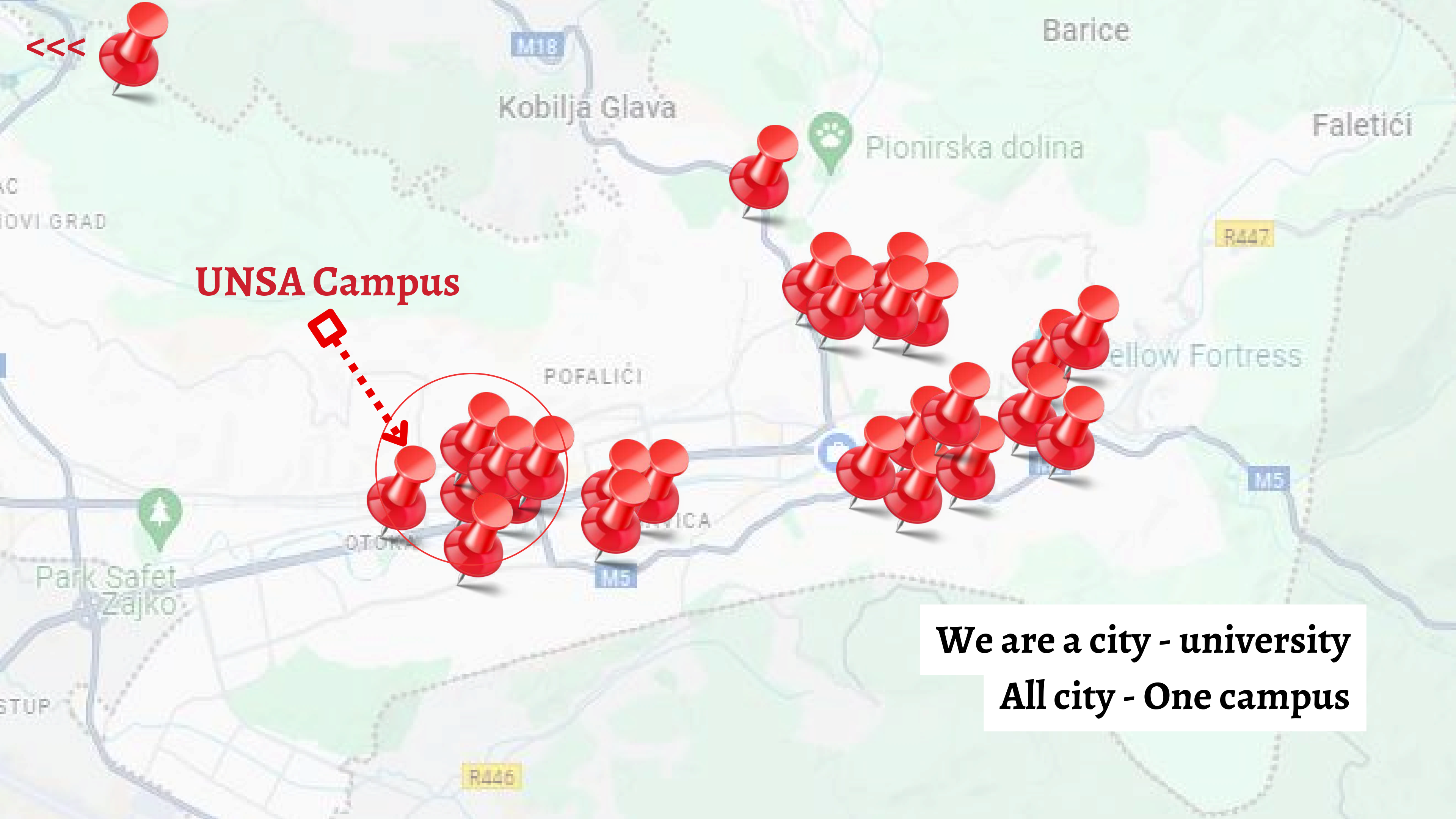
We are a the first university in Bosnia and Herzegovina

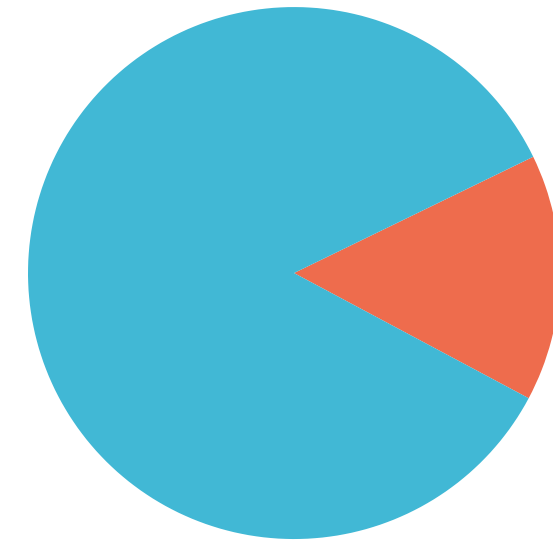

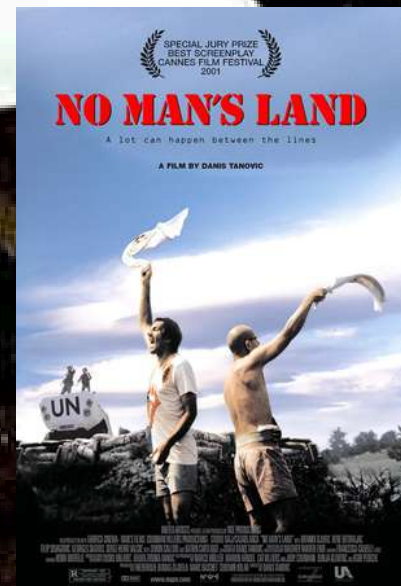
- 15% of Sarajevo's population are students

- Warm, welcoming atmosphere — “You’ll never drink coffee alone!”

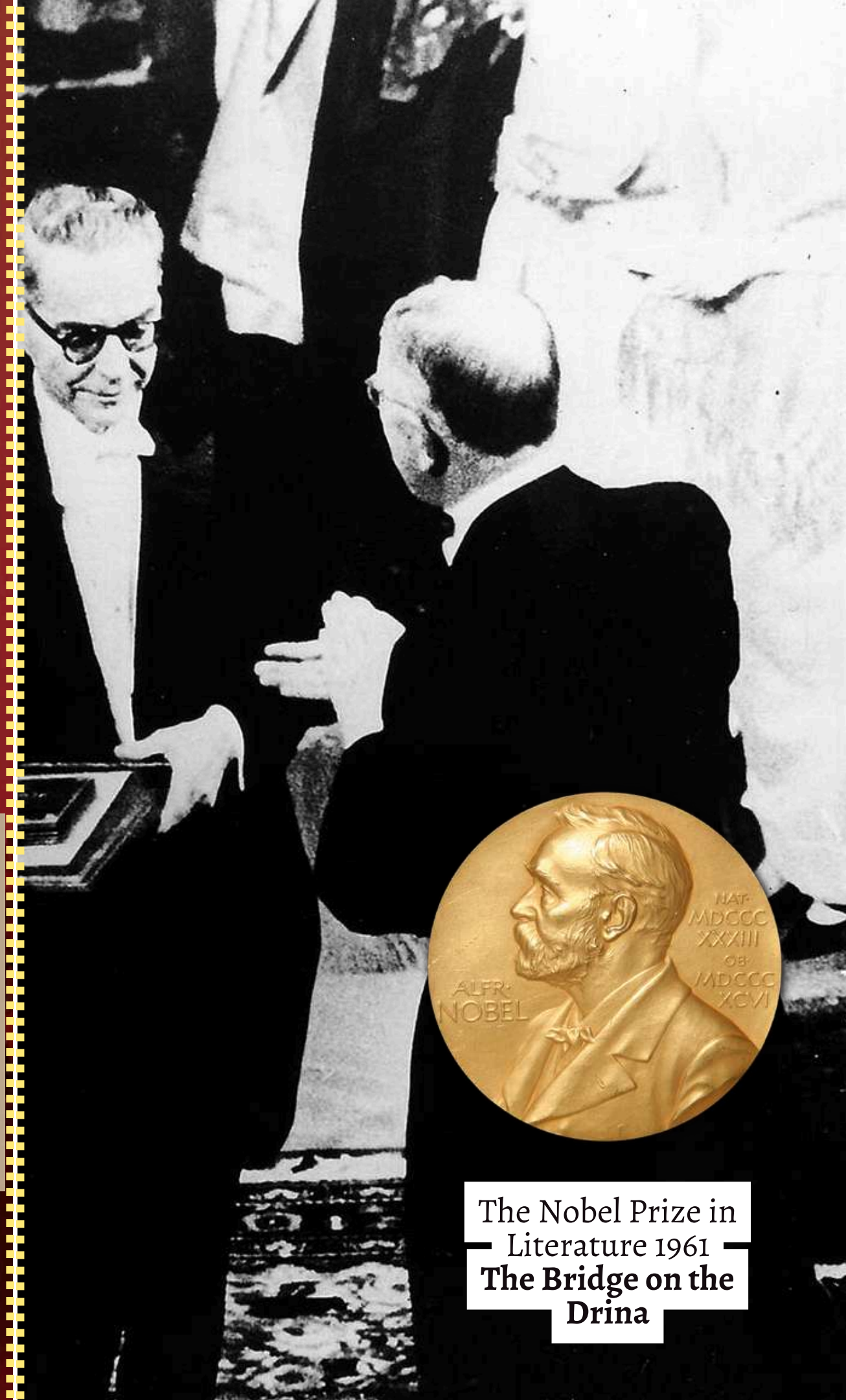

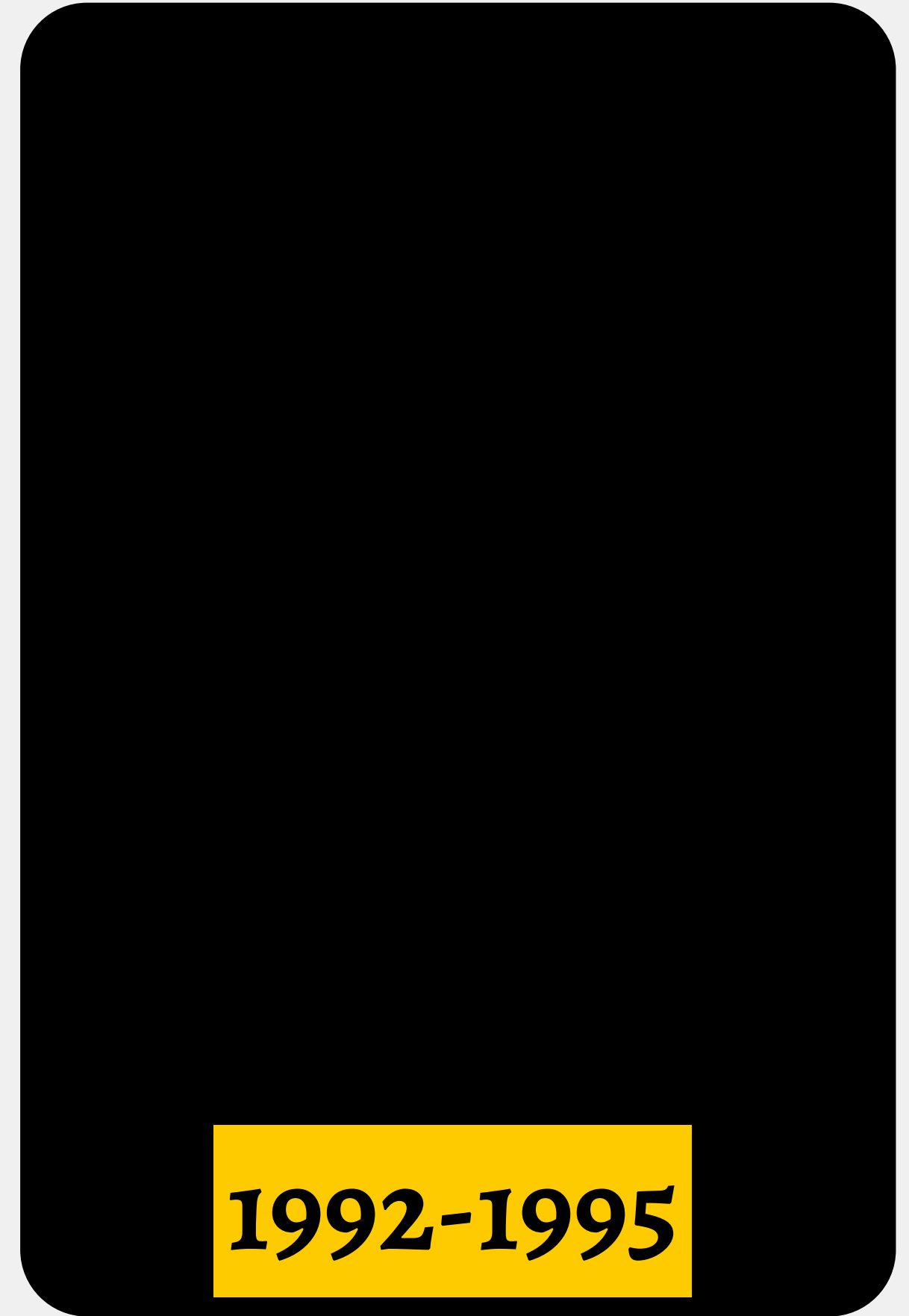

Bosnia and Herzegovina (and UNSA) enters Erasmus+ program **2014-2021**, followed by **2021-2027**

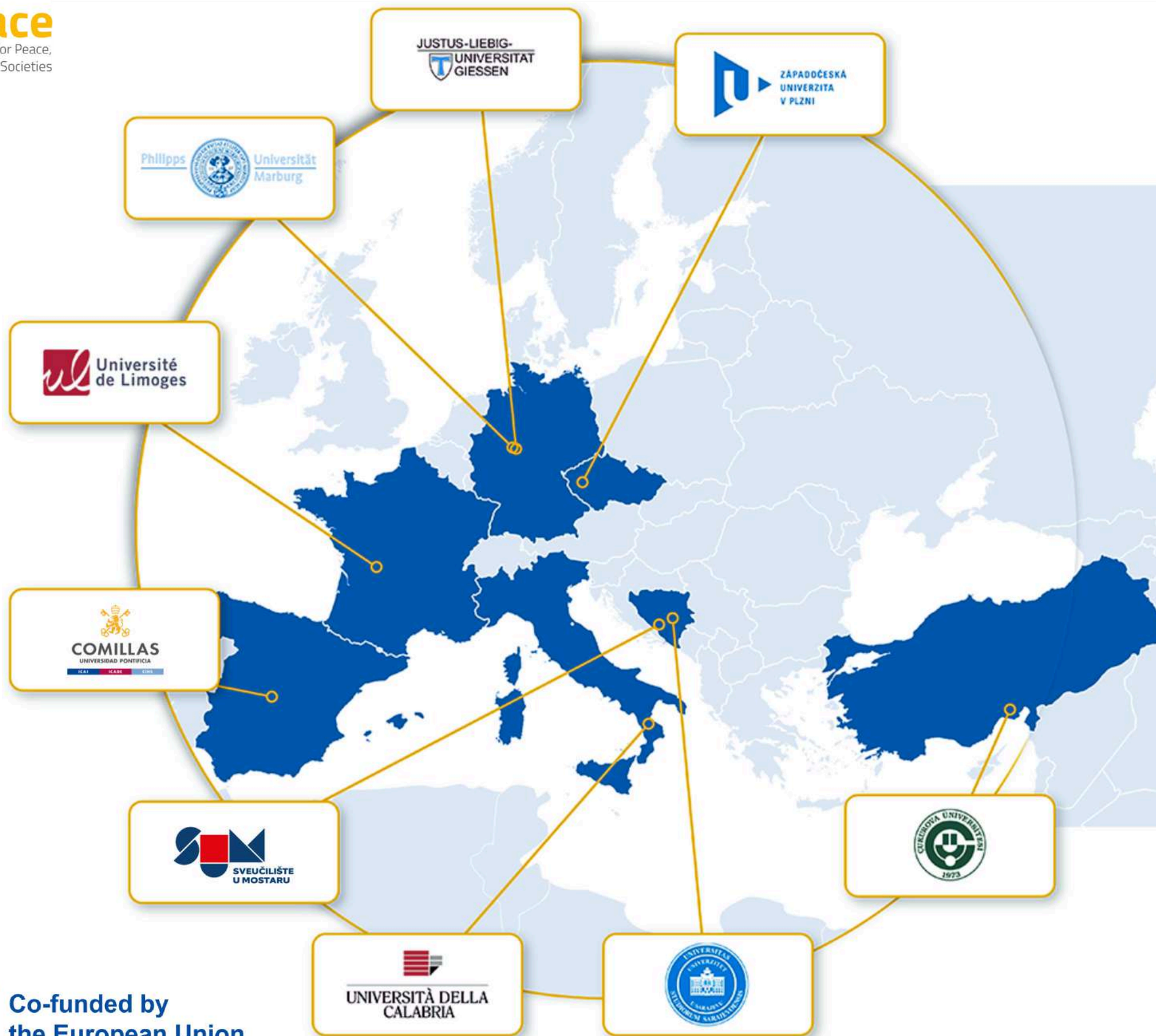

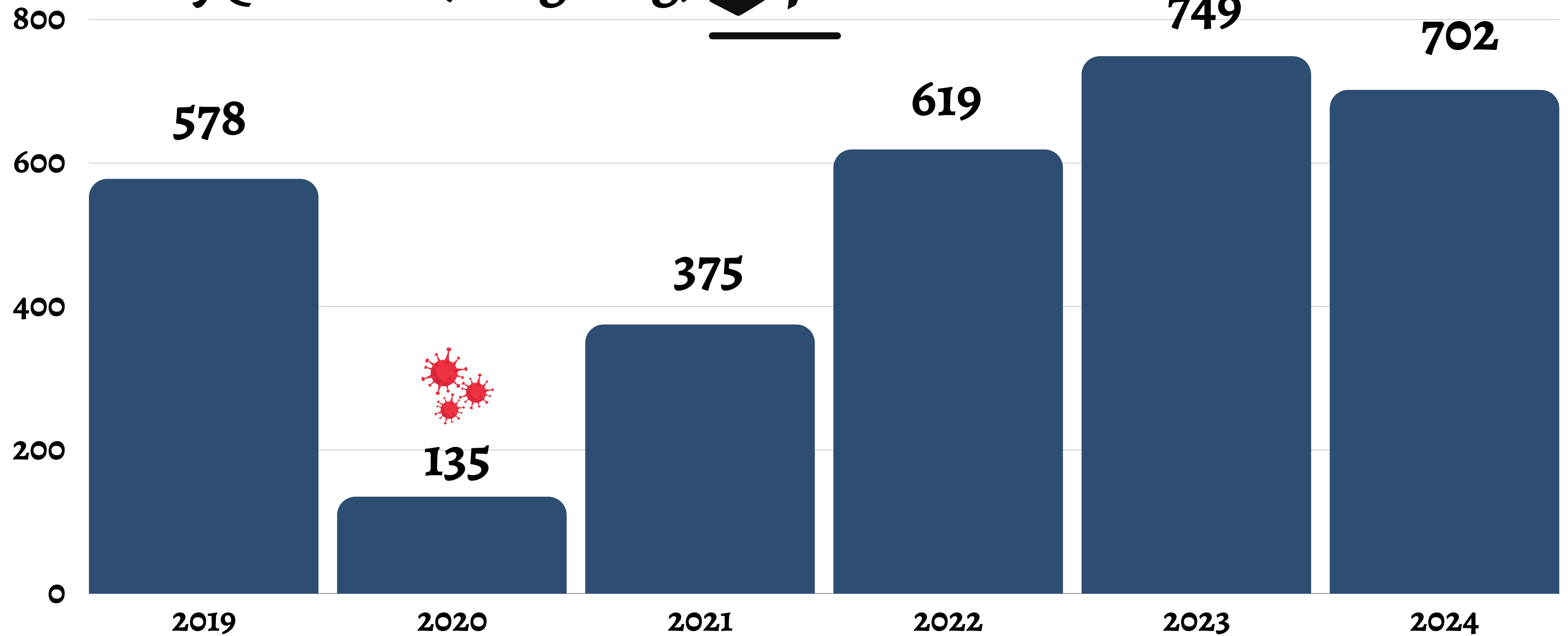


Mobility@UNSA

Mobility@UNSA

- Active international mobility (incoming and outgoing)
- Mobility of students and staff members **is not a centralized process at UNSA.**
- It can be coordinated:
 - at the university level
 - at the departmental level
- IRO prepares **yearly reports** on international relations activities and projects throughout the year and collects information on all implemented mobilities
- Most popular mobilities are through **Erasmus+** and **CEEPUS** programs
