
We are a the first university in Bosnia and Herzegovina

1949 University of Sarajevo is founded


19408 Faculties of Medicine, Forestry, Law and Agriculture are founded


1888 National Museum of B&H is founded (member of UNSA)

UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO - numbers







- 15% of Sarajevo's population are students

- UNSA is a member of Enterprise Europe Network

























B&H (UNSA) enters many EU-funded programs (Tempus, Phare, Cost, FP5, Cards, etc.).




Bosnia and Herzegovina and the University of Sarajevo are given the Erasmus experience by entering **ERASMUS MUNDUS ACTION 2 External Window**




Bosnia and Herzegovina (and UNSA) enters Erasmus+ program **2014-2021**, followed by **2021-2027**



Bosnia and Herzegovina gets **candidate** status for EU





• UNSA's membership in international networks and associations strengthens European and global research institutions and contributes to developing the institution's international profile.




Mobility@UNSA

- Most popular mobilities are through Erasmus+ and CEEPUS programs




