We would like to invite teachers of Slavic languages (Russian, Polish, Czech, Serbian, Croatian, Bosnian, etc.) from the universities of Bosnia and Herzegovina to take part in this STW.

During this working week we will also organize an international conference on "Slavic Studies Today: Liminality and Mediation" and we invite that colleagues from the universities of Bosnia and Herzegovina to take active part in it.
