VMU Botanical Garden is celebrating its centennial in 2023. Show your Staff Week tag at the entrance and visit it free of charge!

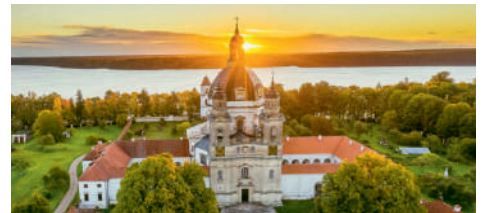
Take bus route **No. 35** from Vytauto Avenue

Pažaislis Monastery is one of the best examples of Baroque architecture in Lithuania.

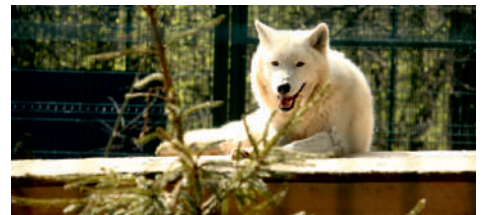
Take trolleybus route **No. 12** from Donelaičio g.

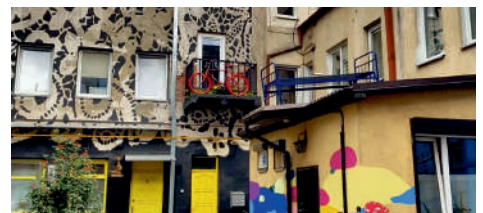
Take bus route **No. 37** from Donelaičio g.

Yard Gallery is famous for its transferred photos of Jewish families that used to live here on building walls.

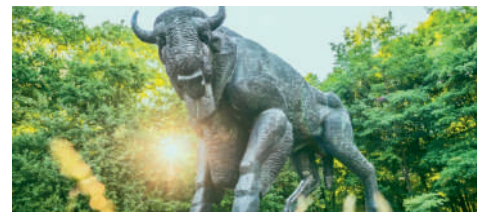
5 minutes walk from the Student's Square



OAK GROVE (AŽUOLYNAS) (Address: Sporto g.)

Located in the Žaliakalnis district the park is a popular promenade and sports place for Kaunas residents. In 2006, the Kaunas Oak Grove Park was listed in the Register of Immovable Cultural Values of the Republic of Lithuania.

Santaka Park which is next to Kaunas Castle is called the heart of Kaunas. Here you can see the confluence of the rivers Nemunas and Neris.

BEST SOUVENIRS FROM LITHUANIA TO BRING HOME

AMBER JEWELRY

Amber is known as “Lithuanian gold,” and many know it for its beauty in pieces of jewellery and art. It is the most popular souvenir from Lithuania.



APPLE CHEESE

Apple cheese (**Lithuanian: Obuolių sūris**) is a traditional Lithuanian dessert, made out of boiled or cooked apples sweetened with sugar. Originally it was made with honey, which was later replaced by sugar.



LITHUANIAN HONEY

It is a product made from Lithuanian plants like trees, meadows and uphill grasses nectar; rich in dissolved flavorings (essential oils), active minerals, plant-based acids and vitamins.



LITHUANIAN MEAD

One of the world's oldest alcoholic drinks, Lithuania has made mead its own over the centuries. The savory materials were given up by honey, carnation blossoms, poplar buds, oak acorns, juniper berries, and many other valuable herbs.



ŠAKOTIS

This many-branched dessert made from many eggs can keep for a long time without losing its shape or flavour. It is more than a dessert - a special souvenir, thousands of which travel from Lithuania to foreign countries every year. By the way, no wedding in Lithuania can be held without this dessert.
