




Bosnian kingdom: state and religious institutions developed the skills of writing, reading, transcribing, illuminating manuscripts and the style of writing, using Cyrillic, Latin, Greek and Glagolitic)

13-15 Century

Gazi-Husrev-bey Madrassah and library was the first highereducation institution of Sufi philosophy, working in the accordance with the defined curricula, executed exams, and awarded diplomas)

Sharia Judiciary School (the higher Islamic Sharia and Theological School studying Sharia Law within three main areas: law, theology and linguistics)

Theological college has followed the program of the Humboldt model universities based on fields of theology, law, philosophy and linguistics)

Bosnia and Herzegovina is integrated in the **Ottomans Empire** brining new education, culture and traditions



Timeline of the University of Sarajevo (and the higher education in Bosnia and Herzegovina)




1949

The **World War I** that was sparked in Sarajevo changes the focus from education to military enforcement

Advocating its purpose since 1928, the Faculty of Agriculture and Forestry in Sarajevo was open which sadly, soon terminated its activities due to the **WW2**

Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Law, and Faculty of Agriculture and Forestry are founded. Followed by the opening of the Technical Faculty and Faculty of Veterinary Medicine two years later, conditions were created to establish the University of Sarajevo.

The first international agreement was signed with the **University of Greifswald, Germany** marking the beginning of the international path of the UNSA

The aggression at B&H and Sarajevo brought great loss in humans and infrastructure. It is estimated that 90.000.000 \$ loss UNSA has suffered in destroyed buildings, classrooms, laboratory equipment. It also influenced on loosing 50% of staff as well as braindrain.







Incoming and outgoing students and staff through Erasmus Mundus/Erasmus+ program (2007-2022)





