

- **1949** University of Sarajevo is founded










14th Winter Olympic Games





The aggression at B&H and Sarajevo brought great loss in humans and infrastructure. It is estimated that 90 million \$ loss UNSA has suffered in destroyed buildings, classrooms, and laboratory equipment. It also influenced the loss of 50% of staff as well as brain drain.


 UNSA's membership in international networks and associations strengthens European and global research institutions and contributes to developing the institution's international profile.

 - KA103 / 131 NO
 - KA107 / 171 YES
- Phase 1 (2014-2021): **220 partner HEIs**
- Phase 2 (2021-2027): **150+ partner HEIs**










Mobility@UNSA

- Most popular mobilities are through Erasmus+ and CEEPUS programs











Rulebook of mobility


- created and adopted in 2018 (revised in 2023)


C A R P E D I E M
